It was such an honor to serve over 300 Thanksgiving meals ON THANKGIVING DAY. The Overflowing Cup has served holiday meals for many years. Three years ago we partnered with the Masonic Lodge in Beloit, who have a wonderful facility & workers who assisted with cooking, set-up & serving. This year we partnered with Beloit Regional Hospice, with volunteers delivering meals to more than 30 hospice patients who had no opportunity to be with family. Carry-outs were provided for others whose family members were unable to come. We delivered meals to a local domestic violence shelter, men's house & assisted living facility. All were grateful to receive a hot Thanksgiving meal. We were blessed with many volunteers in the community who were ready & willing to help set up for the meal, prepare the food in the kitchen, serve the meals & engage in clean up afterwards.

To contribute to the spiritual focus, musicians, Stan Riley & Paul Hieser provided music during the meal. There were also many opportunities to pray with people who were in need & were facing illness or difficult personal & family situations.

What are some of the things we have done to help others this year?

We helped MANY people in 2015 including:

- Disbursed many gas/food cards
- Emergency food and meds for people
- Given rides to pantries, treatment, job & MD appointments
- Referred many to homeless and abuse shelters.
- Begun a Wednesday night CUP **RECOVERY Meeting led by Pastor Butch Martin**
- Prayer & Support to those in need/crisis, as every day we have opportunity to share the hope that is within us thru JESUS.
